¹⁰ A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.

¹¹ Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil.

¹² For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

¹³ Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.

TAKE ON STRENGTH Part 1

Learning to take on strength is a serious matter. It is the will of God for disciples to be trained in the practice of taking on strength that is not their own.

The command to be strong in the LORD, and in the strength of His might, is given in view of the fact that our struggle—our warfare is not against flesh and blood. Therefore, since we face matters of life and death—since it is possible for us to not benefit fully from present provision—since—since no man has strength enough to withstand the forces of wickedness in the heavenly places, everyone who desires to experience the prophetic realities set before us in scripture must learn to take on strength.

¹ A Psalm of David. The Lord *is* my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord *is* the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

Psalms 119:28 (NKJV)

²⁸ My soul melts from heaviness; Strengthen me according to Your word.

Isaiah 11:2 (NASB)

² The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, The spirit of wisdom and understanding, The spirit of counsel and strength, The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.
