## THE DISCIPLE'S PRAYER

### 1 Corinthians 2:12-14

<sup>12</sup> Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God,

<sup>13</sup> which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual *thoughts* with spiritual *words*.

<sup>14</sup> But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

The disciple's prayer has been dissected, prayed, and preached through the eyes of the natural-minded man. Often, it is prayed without any thought to the possibility that it is truly needed, or that an answer should truly be expected. However, in these last days, God wants to raise disciples, those who accept that God's house is a house of prayer, and that prayer depends on the Name of the Lord being revealed to the heart of faith.

Scripture shows that the only way we can truly know reality, is if we are willing to embrace the Name of the Lord, as it is revealed:
